

Phoenix Campsite Etiquette

Thank you for using Phoenix Campsite. Here are some principles we would like you to follow when on site which are based around the Scout Laws and Promise:

The Scout Promise
On my honour, I promise that I will do my best
To do my duty to God and to the Queen,
To help other people
And to keep the Scout Law

The Scout Law

- 1. A Scout is to be trusted.
- 2. A Scout is loval.
- 3. A Scout is friendly and considerate.
- 4. A Scout belongs to the worldwide family of Scouts.
- 5. A Scout has courage in all difficulties.
- A Scout makes good use of time and is careful of possessions and property
- A Scout has self-respect and respect for others.

There is no on-site Warden, so we trust you to treat the site as if it was your own and for the purposes you have described when booking the site. This includes providing an accurate declaration of visitor numbers and fair use of facilities and equipment provided as well as observing any out of bounds areas marked by red and white tape from time to time.

Be considerate of our neighbours. No climbing over fences to retrieve balls and please pitch fires so that smoke does not bother them. Please observe a quiet time after 10pm and before 8am. In fact no on-site activities e.g. Cratestacking etc. can take place after 10pm or before 8am.

There is a no smoking policy on the whole site. Alcohol is tolerated for adult private consumption but during events involving young people it should only be after they have retired to their tents and with designated non-drinkers in charge.

Please return any equipment used to where it came from and in a clean condition. Please report any breakages or damage to the bookings secretary on your departure, there may or may not be a charge, we just need to know for the next booking so they can have as good a time as you did.

There are no rubbish bins on site so we request that you incinerate or take away your waste materials. There is a compost heap for food peelings (not food slops) and an aluminium can/foil recycling container located near the campfire circle. Make sure all fire barrels have been emptied into the ash pit (or compost heap) then returned.

Please conduct regular litter picks and lost property sweeps. We will retain anything found for a period but we cannot be held responsible for any losses.

Finally — have a great time and we hope to see you again soon. If you have any suggestions how we can improve your visit for next time let the bookings secretary know on your departure.
